Proceed to 3rd stop light on Fremont St. Go through 3rd light and on the right you will see The Stevenson signs behind the Chevron Station.

From Airport From Monterey Peninsula Airport, take right turn (West) on Highway 68 to Highway 1 South to Downtown Monterey exit. Proceed to 3rd stop light on Fremont St. Go through 3rd light and on the right you will see The Stevenson signs behind the Chevron Station.
